Dear Parents,

The date for the Year 6-8 boys trip to the Adventure Centre at Northstar, is Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March leaving school at 11.30 am. and returning to school by 13.00 Friday 4<sup>th</sup> and the boys will call from school when they arrive.

The following equipment and clothing are necessary:

- Tee shirts plus long sleeve shirts which can be removed but to protect the arms.
- Tracksuit top/sweat shirt for evening
- Tracksuit trousers which again offer protection
- If boys wear shorts these need to be long
- Trainers
- Towel
- Small rucksack
- Tissues/ wet wipes
- High energy snacks - dried fruits
- Sunhat
- Sunglasses if suitable
- Sun block
- Small rucksack
- Items for washing
- Torch
- Sleeping Bag or Blanket
- Prayer mat if needed.
- Pillow (Fitted sheet will be provided but no other bedding or pillow)
- Water bottle (at least 750ml capacity)
- Plastic bag for dirty washing

\*Clothing should be suitable for possible wet and activities which may leave their clothes dirty.



The students should bring a packed lunch for Friday lunchtime. There will require energy to participate in the afternoon's activities. So, they will need sandwiches or pasta, fruit, vegetables, high energy snacks e.g. fruit and nuts and their water bottle. Dinner and breakfast are halal and provided at the camp.

There will be 6 teachers from the school as well as the instructors supervising the boys. They do not require mobile telephones or I pads or smart watches and these will be collected from them should they bring them. Staff will have school mobiles with them and can make any necessary calls. It is intended that this provides the boys with physical challenges and improves confidence.
