Dear Grade 3-5 Parents,

We wish to offer our sincere congratulations on the beginning of the Holy Month of Ramadhan, which will start soon. School hours will be 09.00 am to 14.00 and Friday from 9.00 am to 12.00 for KG 1 - Grade 12. Although students should arrive by 08.50 am to prepare for the day.

Students who are not fasting should bring food and leave it in the designated eating rooms until break, when teachers will supervise eating in the room only. Water will be available for non-fasting students at drinking stations which will be shown to the children and are available throughout the day. Students who are fasting may either sit quietly with the Islamic teachers during break or go to the Primary foyer. At 12.30 pm Muslim children in Year 3-5 may go to their Islamic teacher for prayer and Koranic instruction. Other children will stay with their class teacher for English Medium instruction. Please indicate on the slip below which you would prefer for your child and return to your child's class teacher.

In accordance with our directive from the Ministry of Education, Art, Music and Physical Education are removed from the timetable during this month.

The school office will be open from 8.00 am-2.30 pm daily Monday - Thursday and Friday from 8.00 am to 12.00. Ms Hannan will be available from 8.30 am - 2.00 pm daily.

May we also remind you that the school holidays as approved by the Ministry of Education on the attached school calendar remain Friday 29th March to Sunday 14th April with return to school for all students on Monday 15th April for the start of the Summer Term.
