Dear Grade 8-Grade 10 Parents,

As a precautionary measure in response to governments' high priority to the safety of the UAE population, a directive has been issued by the Ministry of Education that learning continues online from Monday 30th March to 3 April at which point the situation will be reviewed. We will await further instruction on that date.

Term 3 Arabic curriculum books have arrived from the MOE. If you wish to collect these please send the full name including family name of student, class to admin@fpa.sch.ae and we will arrange for collection at security. Please do not come to collect without confirmation from admin who will inform you when books are available from security.

Students from Grade 8 to Grade 10 will have pre-recorded lessons plus follow up work on seesaw. All students are aware of the seesaw group they were using before the Spring Break and if they have any issue with the material need to message Ms Lisa or myself using seesaw messaging. School continues to be closed as per the directive, however, for emergency calls What's App message the school mobile on 050 4345358 in English or Arabic and we will contact you. We will also send SMS updates over the online learning period.

As students may need items from school, we are asking that you email admin@fpa.sch.ae with the full name of the student, first name of father, family name, name of teacher plus class so they can find the correct books. This message can be on What's App on the school mobile or by email. This will allow the administrator organizing this process to obtain materials quickly and will call to collect them from security.

We ask that you please check for SMS messages from the school as I will send these for urgent communication. Please know that our team is here to support you in any way we can during this challenging period.
