Dear KG1 Parents,

May I welcome you to KG 1 at Fujairah Private Academy our team are looking forward to the arrival of your children and helping them settle happily into school life. To make this transition as calm and positive as possible, the children will begin on three different days, allowing them to settle in a few at a time and become familiar with their new classroom, routines and teachers. Ms Hanan, the parent liaison, will have informed you by phone of the timing.

This year, we have two KG1 classes, led by Ms Jade and Ms Tina. Both teachers are looking forward to getting to know the children and supporting them as they begin this important stage of their school journey.

We understand that starting school can be an anxious time for parents as well as for children. This will make it easier for staff to communicate directly with you and share any important information about your child's day. We also ask that each child has a spare set of clothes in school. These are always useful in case of any small accidents, spills or other unexpected mishaps during the day.

I would like to thank you for your support and assistance. We look forward to working in partnership with you and to giving your child a happy, secure and successful start to KG1.
